For example, the Philippino community would say that they are gay, whereas in Ireland most transvestites consider themselves to be heterosexual. They can switch between being dressed and being in their natural born gender with ease. Many transvestites do this for sexual gratification, at least initially. They gain a feeling of calmness when dressed, and generally as they get older this need to dress becomes stronger and stronger, which can cause marital stress, divorce and a lot of heartache within the family environment.
